From October 5 to 7, you will be called upon to vote for your representatives to the Conseil d'école (Primary School Council) and the **Conseil d'établissement** (School Board). An electronic vote will be organised by LFI Tokyo. Voter turnout in these elections is essential in order to have a say in decisions that will have a direct impact on your children.

Parents are essential actors in school life. Your elected representatives will attend the deliberative boards to promote transparent governance of the institution.

What are the roles of your representatives? They are your voice on the school boards, providing feedback and making proposals based on your suggestions; they can weigh in on issues that affect your children's education and well-being at school. They will then be able to bring this information back to parents, and make sure they are kept well-informed (minutes of meetings, lycée-café etc).

Who are they? The members of the Parents' Association (FLT-Families of LFI Tokyo) are parents just like you, from extremely diverse personal and professional backgrounds, with children in primary and secondary school, volunteers elected by you to represent you, to advise you and to inform you. FLT is affiliated with Fapée (Federation of parents' associations for overseas French schools), which is represented in most French schools overseas.

AFFORDABLE SCHOOLING TUITION FOR ALL

Objective: Allow access to an LFI Tokyo education, regardless of income.

Commitment:

- -Financial aid: provide assistance with government scholarship French applications; support applicants' claims at the local and national scholarship boards; raise awareness among public officials about the cost of living in Japan and the subsequent impact on families' ability to finance the cost of their children's education.
- -Tuition and budget monitoring: efforts to minimize school fees for all school children in LFI Tokyo, seeking help for families in extreme difficulty. We make sure that spending increases are fair and justified.
- Vigilance on the future of the AEFE: making efforts to ensure the sustained commitment of the French State towards a quality education accessible to all.

IMPROVEMENTS TO CURRICULUM'S ATTRACTIVENESS AND INCLUSIVITY

Objective: Provide access to a high-quality curriculum allowing students to progress at their best pace.

Commitment:

- -Careful monitoring of the Covid situation to ensure minimum impact on schooling.
- -In primary school: Follow-up of the language curriculum reorganisation, to respond to the needs of all the children, according to the individual educational requirements of each family, without any lowering of standards.
- -In secondary school: follow-up on the language curriculum restructuring to ensure pedagogic continuity from the primary school onward; information on all the available options throughout the program and after the baccalaureate. Follow-up of the OIB (International Option of the Baccalaureate) and the Oriental /European Sections.
- -Working group on children with special educational needs, to build an inclusive school for all.

BETTER COMMUNICATION BETWEEN LFI TOKYO AND FAMILIES

Objective: Improve communication between school (management and teachers) and parents; Make sure that the questions raised by families (academic options, canteen, transportation, extracurricular activities, security issues...) receive accurate and timely answers from the school management.

Commitment:

- -Continuous communication via comprehensive information bulletins in French, Japanese and English (minutes of school meetings, briefing notes, etc).
- Follow-up and involvement in the development of the School Project (Projet d'Établissement).
- Raise awareness on the prevention of high-risk behaviour involving alcohol, drugs and tobacco, bullying and theft.
- Advice for newcomers pairing with families who are already familiar with the school (FLT sponsorship).
- Information exchanges to bring the school community to life (lycée-café)
