First period events

Lycées-Cafés



On **September 17th**, we held our first International Lycée-Café of the year.

We chose a friendly and informal format for this first event, focused on conversation, welcoming new families, and creating connections.

Some of our FLT partners were also present to introduce themselves and answer your questions!

On October 8th, we held the "Lycée-Café" in Japanese at the LFI Tokyo auditorium.

More than 40 Japanese-speaking parents gathered to exchange ideas and experiences about their children's education, from preschool through high school!

Five of the 21 FLT partners were also present for a brief presentation of their services.

The morning ended with informal small-group discussions, further encouraging the sharing of experiences among parents.

Inclusive school group

On the morning of Saturday, October 4th, the Inclusive

Education group of the FLT organized a gathering, inviting parents involved to come together for a friendly and supportive exchange with other parents, professionals, and members of the school community.

Twelve parents attended, along with two professionals — Ms. Kibe-Crenn (psychologist) and Ms. Moreels (speech therapist) — and two members of the school staff: Mr. Teissonière (Primary School Principal) and Ms. Bartagnon (Special Education Teacher for students with special needs – EBEP).

The welcoming and informal format of this kind of meeting allows parents to share freely in a safe, confidential space, where they feel heard and understood by peers who face similar situations.

Parents were able to talk about their own experiences, listen to others, and leave with some ideas or new perspectives to explore for their own families.

They also had the opportunity to ask questions to better understand the many acronyms surrounding inclusive education: PAP, PPS, MDPH, Gevasco...

The staff members present also found the meeting valuable, as it helped them gain deeper insight into what parents of EBEP students go through — enabling them to provide better support.

More meetings like this will be held throughout the year.

Canteen visits

Since the beginning of the year, two visits to the cafeteria have been organized, giving around ten parents the opportunity to discover both the environment where our children have their lunches and the meals served to them.

In our opinion, these visits are an excellent way to better understand how this important moment of their day unfolds, while also gaining a bit more perspective on the remarks our children may share.

Among other things, we discussed the following topics:

A new system in the cafeteria

Every day, the school catering service at LFI Tokyo prepares and serves over 1,200 meals, and more than 85% of students eat at the cafeteria. Starting this school year, a new meal tracking system has been implemented for middle and high school students. Each student has a personal identification code, which was shared with families at the end of August.

Families can access an online portal that allows them to monitor cafeteria visits and manage their child's meal account.

For preschool and elementary students, the cafeteria system remains unchanged.





The Cafeteria for Middle/High School

At the middle/high school cafeteria, breakfast, snacks, sandwiches, salads, and a selection of coffees are served. It is also open to all middle school students.

Wait Times at the Cafeteria for Middle and High School Students at the Start of the School Year

At the beginning of the school year, as cafeteria registrations are not yet finalized for all students, it is necessary to verify each student's identity and allergy information individually. The cafeteria supervisors must be especially vigilant to ensure no risks are taken, which also leads to longer service times.

School supplies

This year, for the third consecutive year, the FLT offered you a school supply delivery service through the company LDE. This initiative was prepared over several months to allow you to order the necessary supplies in advance for an easier back-to-school experience. Thank you to everyone who renewed their trust in us! This year, we were able to distribute school supplies on the first day of school as planned!

As for textbooks, the partnership between Maison Petit Renard, FLT, and LFI Tokyo also made it possible to ensure on-time delivery and quality service provided by our bookstore partner.

A **book exchange** was organized in parallel through WhatsApp groups for the items that are common to the lists from previous years.



Sponsorship Program

At the beginning of this year, we relaunched the FLT sponsorship program, which allows families who already attend the school to welcome new families, whether they are coming from the Japanese system, from France, or from another country.




The autumn break is already here, and we hope you'll enjoy this time to relax with your family.
